8.4 Travel and Transportation Allowance

Summary of Policy

An ODSP recipient who resides in a long-term care home under the **Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007**, which was formerly an approved charitable home for the aged under the **Charitable Institutions Act** may be eligible to receive an amount not exceeding \$30 each month he or she resides in the former approved charitable home, if they require financial assistance to travel in the community.

Summary of Directive

- A monthly amount not exceeding \$30 may be paid to ODSP recipients who live in a long-term care home under the Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007, which was formerly an approved charitable home for the aged under the **Charitable Institutions Act** if, in the opinion of the Director, they require financial assistance to travel in the community.

Intent of Policy

To provide an amount for community travel and transportation for residents of a long-term care home under the Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007, which was formerly an approved charitable home for the aged under the **Charitable Institutions Act**.

Application of Policy

When a recipient who is residing in a Charitable Institution requires funds to travel in the community, a monthly amount not exceeding \$30 may be provided.
