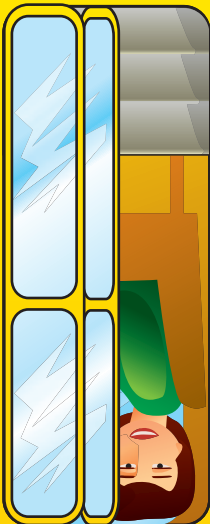


SAFETY RULES

1 Getting On and Off the Bus

- Be at the bus stop before the bus comes.
- Wait for the bus at a safe place away from the road.
- The bus driver will tell you when to get on.
- Always use the hand rail.
- Never push or shove.
- Take two giant steps away from the bus when getting off.
- Walk, don't run away from the bus.

2 On the bus

- Sit facing the driver, feet in front of you.
- Keep hands and your head inside the bus.
- Keep the aisle clear at all times.
- Always follow the bus driver's instructions.

DANGER ZONE →



3 Crossing the Road

- Always cross the road in front of the bus, never behind.
- Take at least 10 giant steps in front of the bus.
- Pass the crossing arm; stop and look at the driver to give you the signal to cross.
- Walk, never run across the road.



This is the DANGER ZONE around the bus.

Remember:

- If you can touch the bus, you are too close!
- Use 10 GIANT STEPS to take you out of the DANGER ZONE.
- Be sure you can see the driver and that the driver sees you.
- IF YOU DROP ANYTHING IN THE DANGER ZONE, NEVER STOP TO PICK IT UP. Ask an adult or the driver to help.
