## Appendix 2: Routine Activities Prompt Worksheet – Case<sup>1</sup>

When interviewing a case, ensure that the following activity prompts are considered to identify a possible source of infection (Acquisition Exposures) within the 14 days prior to the onset of symptoms (or 14 days prior to positive specimen collection date if never symptomatic): work; school; visitors at home; volunteer activities; daycare; religious activities; social activities (restaurants, shopping- including grocery stores); sports; visits to acute care settings, long-term care homes, retirement homes, medical labs, dentists, and other health care providers; contact with ill persons; and contact with agricultural farm animals.
