MLAS Release 2.5.10 Upgrade Alert Claim Abstracts/Assessment Work Reporting

Updated versions of the Mining Lands Administration System (MLAS) are tested and installed regularly as part of our ongoing efforts to bring you one of the most comprehensive mining lands management systems in the world. As of May 1, the following applications and/or functions have been improved or newly-implemented:

1. Claim abstract updates:

- Claim abstracts can be printed directly from the map viewer.
- Users may now view and print a claim holder's mailing address and contact information directly from the claim abstract. This feature is available for all claims in MLAS.
- The wording in abstract entries have been changed for clarity and accuracy.
- Claim abstracts now correctly display the expected anniversary dates regardless of what a user's time zone setting may be.

2. Assessment Work Reporting - Maximum Yearly Distribution:

- The yearly maximum distribution allowance correctly resets at the end of the anniversary.
- If a claim has been granted an extension of time, the distribution allowance resets once the previous assessment year's requirements have been met.

3. Double Clicking:

- Double clicking the 'confirm' button when submitting transactions would result in duplication of information such as submissions, events, notifications and emails. This has been changed so users no longer have the ability to double click.
