WHERE ARE THEY?

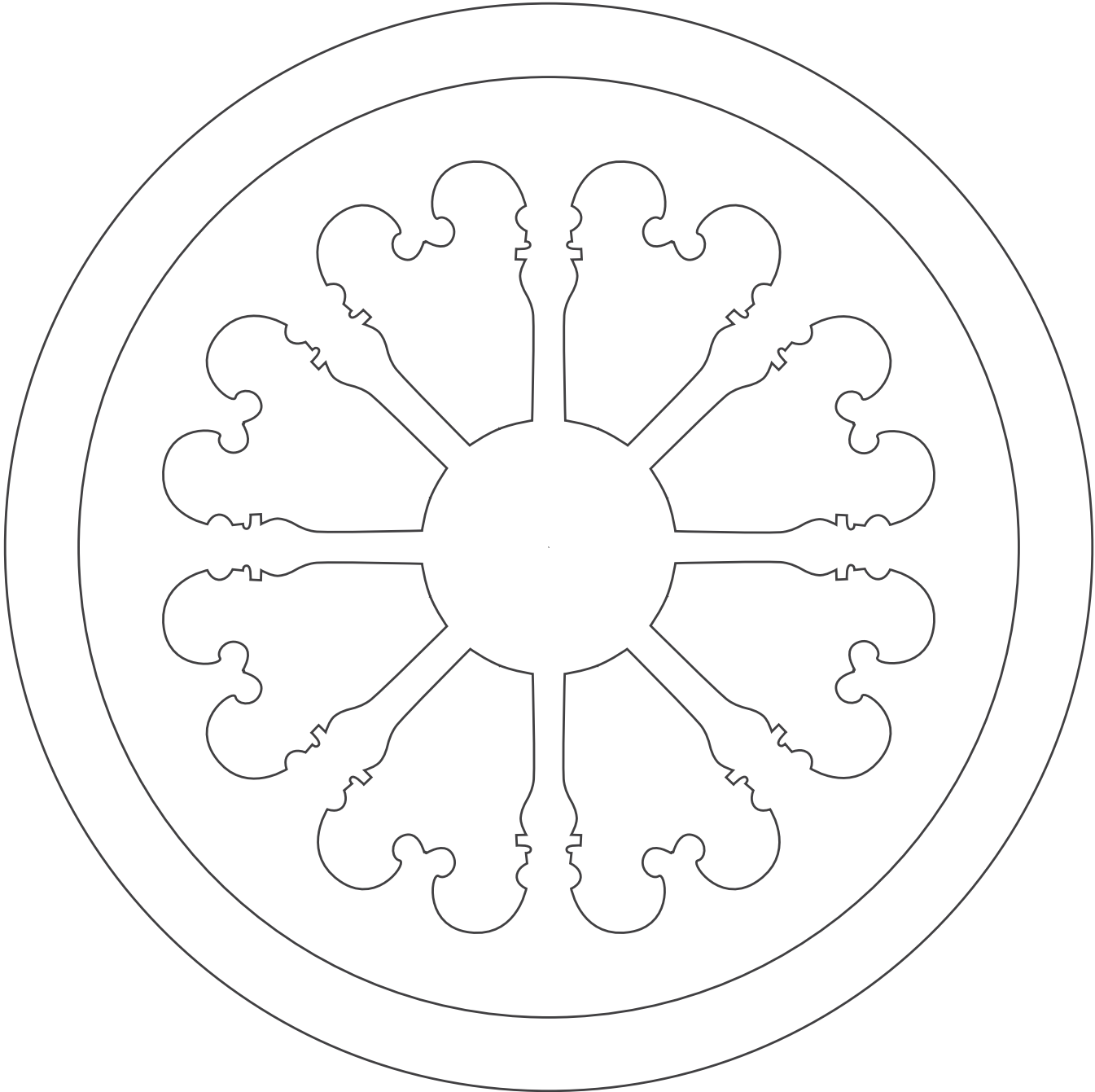
