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Ontario apprenticeship training tax credit

Note: Only eligible expenditures for apprentices who started apprenticeship programs after December 31, 2016, and before November 15, 2017, can be included in the calculation of this credit.

If the total salaries and wages paid in the previous year were:

- \$600,000 or more, enter 25% of the total eligible expenditures for all apprentices on line 8
- \$400,000 or less, enter 30% of the total eligible expenditures for all apprentices on line 8
- more than \$400,000 but less than \$600,000, use Worksheet ON479 to calculate the amount to enter on line 8

Enter the total amount claimed for **all** apprentices in qualifying apprenticeships. (1)
