Dear Mr. Speaker:

Please find below a report regarding a regulation made on February 16, 2021 under the *COVID-19 Related Measures Act*, SBC 2020, c. 8 (CRMA). This report is presented pursuant to subsection 4 (2) of the CRMA.

Subsection 4 (4) of the CRMA requires that this report be laid before the Legislative Assembly as soon as possible. Members of the Legislative Assembly have expressed to me their desire that, despite the Legislative Assembly not currently sitting, reports made under Section 4 of the CRMA be distributed to them by your office as soon as is possible.

This regulation (B.C. Reg. 33/2021) provides for the repeal of Item 1 (Bylaw Enforcement Officer (COVID-19) Order) and Item 5 (Provincial Compliance Officer (COVID-19) Order) in Schedule 2 to the CRMA on July 10, 2021, the latest date until which a COVID-19 Provision under the CRMA can currently be in force. This enables bylaw enforcement officers and provincial compliance officers to continue to assist health officers under the *Public Health Act* to enforce public health orders in relation to the COVID-19 pandemic.
