Dear Mr. Speaker:

Please find below a report regarding Regulation 187/2021 made on July 9, 2021 under the *COVID-19 Related Measures Act*, SBC 2020, c. 8 (CRMA). This report is presented pursuant to subsection 4 (2) of the CRMA.

Subsection 4 (4) of the CRMA requires that this report be laid before the Legislative Assembly as soon as possible.

The regulation extends item 23.2 of Schedule 2 of CRMA, (M256/2020, BC Ferries Medical Travel (COVID-19) Order) until December 31, 2021. It continues to ensure that BC Ferries will implement all procedures necessary to provide priority medical-assured loading on the first available vessel for any individual, their vehicle and an escort, as part of the Province's continued COVID-19 pandemic response, and that even when the State of Emergency ends that medical-assured loading is protected for people travelling by ferry for scheduled medical treatment as long as they have a signed letter from their medical practitioner and the Medical Travel Assistance Program form.
