#### THE COURT INTERPRETER PROGRAM

The Court Interpreter Program in BC provides spoken and visual language interpreters, and CART captioners at all levels of court and for all proceedings. The program is overseen by the Court Interpreter Program Lead.

#### **BECOMING A COURT INTERPRETER**

#### Step 1: Complete the application form

Before you submit your application, ensure that you have:

- completed all relevant sections
- included evidence of qualifications where requested
- signed and dated the application.

#### Step 2: Submit your completed form

Your completed application form, along with all relevant documentation, must be emailed or mailed to:

#### **Step 3: Review by Court Services Branch**

The Court Interpreter Program Lead will:

- evaluate your application
  - check your references
  - assign you a level (e.g. level 1 or level 2) based on qualifications

#### Step 4: Entering into a contract

If your application is successful, the CIP lead will:

- send you a service contract to review and sign
- provide you with information about completing a criminal record check

The Court Services Branch will collect your personal information as part of your participation in the Court Interpreter Program in accordance with Section 26(c) of the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act.
