

COVID-19 vaccine clinics: What to expect



Getting a COVID-19 vaccine is easy, just follow these simple steps!



Call your health centre for clinic information, go to the GN's website and social media pages, or listen to your local radio station.

On the day of your appointment, wear a mask!



Bring a valid photo ID, and proof of residency (e.g. NTI enrollment cards, rental agreement, utility bill, proof of employment, etc).

Bring a list of your medications, or the medications themselves.



A nurse will ask questions to make sure that receiving the vaccine is a safe choice for you.

The vaccine is given by an injection in your upper arm.



After the injection, you will be asked to stay for 15-30 minutes to be monitored for reactions. Health care staff are there to assist if needed.

Thank you for getting the vaccine! Remember, a second dose is important and needed for maximum protection. Keep an eye out for the next clinic dates in your community.
