EXECUTIVE COUNCIL ACT  
ATTORNEY GENERAL  
AUTHORITY TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT

Pursuant to clause 10(a) of the *Executive Council Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. E-12 Council authorized the Attorney General to enter into an agreement with the Government of Canada, as represented by the Minister of Justice, to renew funding for legal aid in serious criminal matters, in matters pursuant to the *Youth Criminal Justice Act*, and in immigration and refugee matters in Prince Edward Island for the period April 1, 2006 to March 31, 2007, such as more particularly described in the draft agreement.

L-5 Council granted permission to West Cape Wind Energy Inc. of Toronto, Ontario to acquire, by grant of easement, an interest in a land holding of approximately zero decimal six eight (0.68) acres of land in Lot 8, Prince County, Province of Prince Edward Island, being acquired from West Cape Farms Ltd. of O'Leary, Prince Edward Island.

EXEMPTION FROM

Pursuant to section 21 of the *Prince Edward Island Lands Protection Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. L-5 Council determined that upon transfer to the Community of Abrams Village, land located at Abrams Village in Lot 15, Prince County, Prince Edward Island, being Provincial Property No. 269662, being intended for construction of a community sewage lagoon, and currently owned by the Government of Prince Edward Island, as represented by the Minister of Transportation and Public Works, NOT be identified for non-development use under the Land Identification Program established by the *Prince Edward Island Lands Protection Act* Land Identification Regulations (EC606/95).

REVENUE TAX ACT  
REGULATIONS  
AMENDMENT

Pursuant to subsections 57(1) and (2) of the *Revenue Tax Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. R-14, Council made the following regulations:

**1. Clause 1(1)(q.2) of the *Revenue Tax Act* General Regulations (EC262/60) is amended**

**(a) by the deletion of the semicolon following subclause (vi) and the substitution of the words “, and”; and**

**(b) by the addition of the following after subclause (vi):**

- (vii) an organic combustion system that
  - (A) has a name plate rating of 100 kilowatts or less, and
  - (B) complies with Canadian Standards Association (CSA) B415 or holds a US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) certification,

and includes the combustion appliance, stoking and fuel delivery system of such appliance and the blowers and fans attached to the appliance, but does not include the breaching, exhaust or chimney structure of the system or any materials or services necessary to house the system;

**2. Clause 1(1)(q.2) is amended**

(a) by the deletion of the words “, and” following subclause (vi) and the substitution of a semicolon; and

(b) by the revocation of subclause (vii).

**3. (1) Subject to subsection (2), these regulations are deemed to have come into force on April 1, 2006.**

**(2) Section 2 comes into force on March 31, 2008.**

**EXPLANATORY NOTES**

These regulations amend the definition of “renewable energy equipment” to include organic combustion systems for a two-year period. This will extend tax exempt status to the purchase of these systems for the period from April 1, 2006 to March 31, 2008.
