**ROADS ACT
 HIGHWAY ACCESS REGULATIONS
 AMENDMENT**

Pursuant to subsection 29(1) of the *Roads Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. R-15, Council made the following regulations:

1. Schedule C-3, LOCAL (CLASS 3) HIGHWAYS, of the *Roads Act* Highway Access Regulations (EC580/95) is amended by the addition of the following after subsection 1(214.1):

(214.2) **Easter Road RI31183:** The Easter Road in the settlement of Indian River commencing at a point .3 km from the intersection of Road Index 31078 to the end of the road, a distance of 1.0 km.

2. Schedule D, SEASONAL HIGHWAYS, of the regulations is amended by revocation of subsection 1(217).

3. These regulations come into force on June 9, 2007.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

This amendment will reclassify 1.0 km of the unpaved portion of the Easter Road in the settlement of Indian River from Class "D" Seasonal Road to Class C-3, Local Unpaved Road and enable the Department of Transportation and Public Works to provide year-round maintenance.
