#### ANIMAL HEALTH AND PROTECTION ACT BEE HEALTH REGULATIONS AMENDMENT

Pursuant to sections 4 and 20 of the *Animal Health and Protection Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. A-11.1, Council made the following regulations:

**1. Clause 1(1)(f.1) of the *Animal Health and Protection Act*, *Bee Health Regulations (EC271/01)* is amended by the deletion of the words “egg or sperm” and the substitution of the words “egg, sperm or capped queen cell”.**

**2. These regulations come into force on April 12, 2008.**

#### EXPLANATORY NOTES

**SECTION 1** amends the definition of “genetic material” to include a “capped queen cell”. This amendment will allow the importation into the Province of capped queen cells.

**SECTION 2** provides for the commencement of these regulations.
