Pursuant to subsection 9(2) of the *Prince Edward Island Lands Protection Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. L-5, Council amended the condition of non-development use made pursuant to section 2 of the Land Identification Regulations (EC606/95) in respect of approximately one hundred (100) acres of land, being Provincial Property No. 296376 located in Lot 64, Kings County, Prince Edward Island and currently owned by Marcus Macdonald and Sophie Macdonald, both of Murray River, Prince Edward Island.

Council noted that this amendment will enable subdivision of two lots, each of approximately two decimal five (2.5) acres, and determined that following subdivision, identification for non-development use shall continue to apply to the remaining land.
