BE ADVISED that, placing special trust and confidence in your prudence, courage, loyalty, integrity and ability, We, by and with the advice of Our Privy Council for Canada pursuant to sections 58 and 59 of the Constitution Act, 1867, do hereby appoint you,

H. FRANK LEWIS
LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR OF THE PROVINCE OF PRINCE EDWARD ISLAND

during the pleasure of Our Governor General of Canada effective on the day on which you make and subscribe the Oaths of Allegiance and Office required by section 61 of the Constitution Act, 1867.

AND WE DO HEREBY direct you to carry out your duties in accordance with the powers granted to you by the Constitution Act, 1867 and any other statutes, Our present Commission and the annexed instructions, or instructions that may from time to time be given to you by Our Governor General of Canada or by Our Privy Council for Canada, and in accordance with such laws as are in force in the Province of Prince Edward Island.

AND WE DO HEREBY direct that as soon as you have made and subscribed the Oaths, Our present Commission supersedes Our Commission issued under the Great Seal of Canada on July 26, 2006 appointing the Honourable Barbara Oliver Hagerman to be Lieutenant Governor of the Province of Prince Edward Island.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, We have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent and the Great Seal of Canada to be hereunto affixed.
