EXECUTIVE COUNCIL ACT

 AUTHORITY TO CONSENT TO ASSIGNMENT AGREEMENT

Pursuant to clauses 10(b) and (d) of the *Executive Council Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. E-12 Council authorized the Minister of Health and Wellness to consent to the assignment of the Service Agreement with the Government of Nova Scotia and with McKesson Canada Corporation to EMC Emergency Medical Care Incorporated for delivery of 811 Telecare Services to residents of Prince Edward Island and Nova Scotia from the date of assignment until March 31, 2019, such as more particularly described in the draft agreement.

Council also authorized the Minister of Health and Wellness to approve amendments to Section 31 and Section J of the Service Agreement.

PRINCE EDWARD ISLAND  
 LANDS PROTECTION ACT  
 PROPERTY NO. 015727, LOT 3, PRINCE COUNTY  
 IDENTIFICATION FOR NON-DEVELOPMENT USE  
 AMENDMENT

Pursuant to subsection 9(2) of the *Prince Edward Island Lands Protection Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. L-5, Council amended the condition of non-development use made pursuant to section 2 of the Land Identification Regulations (EC606/95) in respect of approximately five decimal five two (5.52) acres of land, being Provincial Property No. 015727 located at Alma, Lot 3, Prince County, Prince Edward Island and currently owned by Dock Corner Farms Ltd. of Elmsdale, Prince Edward Island.

Council noted that this amendment will enable subdivision of one (1) lot of approximately five decimal five two (5.52) acres for residential purposes, and determined that following subdivision, identification for non-development use shall continue to apply to the remaining land.

This Order-in-Council comes into force on October 4, 2016.
