

**EC2020-175****LIQUOR CONTROL ACT****REGULATIONS  
AMENDMENT**

Made by the Prince Edward Island Liquor Control Commission and approved by the Lieutenant Governor in Council under the *Liquor Control Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. L-14:

**1. Section 91 of the *Liquor Control Act* Regulations (EC740/75) is amended by the addition of the following after subsection (5):**

(6) The Commission and the following persons may convey and deliver unopened liquor purchased from the Commission or from a license holder referred to in clause (a) to a purchaser: Delivery of unopened liquor

- (a) the holder of a winery license, distiller's license or micro-brewery license;
- (b) a person acting on behalf of the Commission or a license holder referred to in clause (a).

**2. Subsection 91(6) of the regulations is revoked on August 31, 2020.**

**3. These regulations come into force on March 21, 2020.**

**EXPLANATORY NOTES**

**SECTION 1** amends the *Liquor Control Act* Regulations to add a new subsection 91(6) that permits the Commission or a specified license holder or person to convey and deliver unopened liquor purchased from the Commission or the license holder to a purchaser.

**SECTION 2** provides that the new subsection 91(6) is revoked on August 31, 2020.

**SECTION 3** provides for the commencement of the regulations.
