EXPLANATORY NOTES

SECTION 1 amends the *Wildlife Conservation Act* Fur Harvesting Regulations (EC663/04) by revoking subsection 2(4) and substituting a new subsection 2(4) that authorizes the Department to issue trapper registration numbers. The amendment eliminates a requirement for the Department to also issue metal dies for stamping the number on traps, which is no longer necessary. The section also amends subsection 2(5) of the regulations, which contains a reference to the metal dies.

SECTION 2 revokes Schedule C to the regulations and substitutes a new Schedule C with an updated list of approved body-gripping traps.

SECTION 3 provides for the commencement of the regulations.
