# EXECUTIVE COUNCIL ACT MINISTER OF ECONOMIC GROWTH, TOURISM AND CULTURE AUTHORITY TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT (FOREIGN CREDENTIAL RECOGNITION PROGRAM LABOUR MARKET INTEGRATION FUNDING AGREEMENT) WITH THE GOVERNMENT OF CANADA

Pursuant to clause 10(a) of the Executive Council Act R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. Under authority of subsection 27(2) of the *Judicature Act*, R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. J-2.1, Council appointed Karen A.
