E-12 Council authorized the Minister of Finance to enter into an agreement with the Province of New Brunswick, as represented by Service New Brunswick; the Province of Newfoundland and Labrador, as represented by the Minister Responsible for the Public Procurement Agency and the Minister for Intergovernmental and Indigenous Affairs; and the Province of Nova Scotia, as represented by the Minister of Service Nova Scotia & Internal Services to outline the procedures for the issuance of joint procurement, for the provision of corporate procurement card services, effective upon signing by all four Parties until the expiry of seven years from the date of execution or a contract has been awarded to a service provider for each Party, whichever comes first, such as more particularly described in the draft agreement.

REAL PROPERTY TAX ACT
REGULATIONS
AMENDMENT

Pursuant to subsection 43(1) of the *Real Property Tax Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. R-5, Council made the following regulations:

1. Subsection 9(1) of the *Real Property Tax Act* Regulations (EC512/72) is revoked and the following substituted:

9. (1) Subject to subsection (1.1), all taxes levied pursuant to the Act that are unpaid or partly unpaid when due shall bear interest at the rate of 1% per month on the unpaid amount until paid. Interest rate -
unpaid taxes

(1.1) Deferred taxes referred to in subsection 14(9) of the Act shall bear interest at the rate of 0% per month. Interest rate -
deferred taxes

2. These regulations come into force on January 1, 2022.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

SECTION 1 revokes subsection 9(1) of the *Real Property Tax Act* Regulations (EC512/72) and substitutes a new subsection 9(1) to reduce the interest rate for unpaid taxes to 1% per month, and a new subsection (1.1) that provides that deferred taxes referred to in subsection 14(9) of the Act shall bear interest at the rate of 0% per month. The interest rate in the new subsection (1.1) has not been changed but it has been set out in a separate subsection for clarity and in conformity with proper drafting rules.

SECTION 2 provides that these amendments come into force on January 1, 2022.

**ROADS ACT
HIGHWAY ACCESS REGULATIONS
AMENDMENT**

Pursuant to subsection 29(1) of the *Roads Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. R-15, Council made the following regulations:

1. Schedule C-3, LOCAL (CLASS 3) HIGHWAYS, to the *Roads Act* Highway Access Regulations (EC580/95) is amended by the addition of the following after subsection 1(77):

(77.1) Route 260 Frenchfort Road: The unpaved portion of Route 260 commencing at the intersection of Route 2 in the settlement of Dunstaffnage to the intersection of Route 2 in the settlement of Ten Mile House.

2. These regulations come into force on July 3, 2021.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

SECTION 1 amends Schedule C-3 to the *Roads Act* Highway Access Regulations (EC580/95) by adding the unpaved portion of Route 260 commencing at the intersection of Route 2 in the settlement of Dunstaffnage to the intersection of Route 2 in the settlement of Ten Mile House. This section is currently not listed in the Highway Access Regulations and thus is considered non-essential, but it is now being maintained as a year-round highway by the Department of Transportation and Infrastructure.

SECTION 2 provides for the commencement of the regulations.
