Pursuant to clauses 10(a) and (b) of the *Executive Council Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. E-12 Council authorized the Minister of Agriculture and Forestry to enter into an agreement with the Governments of Canada and the other provinces (excepting Alberta), as represented by their Ministers responsible for agriculture, to amend the Net Income Stabilization Account Program to provide greater flexibility for participants to access their accounts, increase income thresholds, and reduce the waiting period to rejoin the program, and to make administrative changes, such as more particularly described in the draft agreement.

ESTIMATE OF EXPENDITURE
FISCAL YEAR 2003-2004**

This Council in Committee, having under consideration the Estimates of Expenditure required to carry on the public services of the Province for the fiscal year ending 31 March 2004, and amounting in all to the sum of one billion fifty-one million, nine hundred and sixty-three thousand and eight hundred dollars (\$1,051,963,800) which amount includes the sum of twenty-eight million two hundred and fifty thousand dollars (\$28,250,000) for capital expenditures, together with a sum sufficient for similar expenditure, to carry on the public services of the Province from the expiration of the fiscal year ending 31 March 2004 up to and until the final passage of the Estimates for the year ending 31 March 2005, it was and is hereby recommended that the Estimates be approved by His Honour, the Lieutenant Governor of the Province of Prince Edward Island, and be presented to the Legislative Assembly during the present session thereof.
