APPOINTMENT AND DESIGNATION

Pursuant to subsection 2(2) of the *Energy Corporation Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. E-7 Council appointed the Deputy Minister of Environment and Energy to serve at pleasure as a director of the Corporation (vice the Deputy Minister of Development and Technology), and further, pursuant to subsection 3(3) of the said Act, designated the Deputy Minister of Environment and Energy to be chairperson, all to come into force effective 9 October 2003.

Pursuant to subsection 5(1) of the *Public Departments Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. P-29 Council

1. Disestablished the Department of Agriculture and Forestry.
2. Disestablished the Department of Fisheries, Aquaculture and Environment.
3. (a) established the Department of Agriculture, Fisheries, Aquaculture and Forestry;
  - (b) styled the title of the Minister presiding over the said department the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries, Aquaculture and Forestry;
  - (c) styled the titles of the Deputy Ministers of the said department the Deputy Minister of Agriculture and Forestry, and the Deputy Minister of Fisheries and Aquaculture; and
  - (d) transferred to the said department and to the said Minister, all powers, duties and functions previously held by the Minister of Agriculture and Forestry or the Minister of Fisheries and Aquaculture, *except* those relating to the harness racing industry (which shall be the responsibility of the Provincial Treasurer) or Acadian and Francophone Affairs (which shall be represented by the Minister of Community and Cultural Affairs).
4. (a) established the Department of Environment and Energy;
  - (b) styled the title of the Minister presiding over the said department the Minister of Environment and Energy;
  - (c) styled the titles of the Deputy Minister and Assistant Deputy Minister of the said department the Deputy Minister of Environment and Energy and the Assistant Deputy Minister, Environment; and,



(d) transferred to the said department and to the said Minister

(i) all powers, duties and functions previously held by the Minister of Environment, and

(ii) powers duties and functions relating to energy, previously held by the Minister of Development and Technology and including responsibility for all programs and services of the Energy and Minerals Division and of the Prince Edward Island Energy Corporation, but excluding responsibility for the administration and supervision of the *Electric Power and Telephone Act* (which shall remain the responsibility of the Minister of Development and Technology).

5. Transferred from the Minister of Tourism to the Minister of Development and Technology, control and supervision of the Prince Edward Island Liquor Control Commission.

6. Transferred from the Provincial Treasurer to the Minister of Transportation and Public Works (as Minister responsible for the Status of Women) control and supervision of the Interministerial Women's Secretariat.

This Order comes into force effective 9 October 2003.
