#### GASOLINE TAX ACT REGULATIONS AMENDMENT

Pursuant to section 9 of the *Gasoline Tax Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. G-3, Council made the following regulations:

- 1. Subsection 15(2) of the  $Gasoline\ Tax\ Act\ Regulations\ (EC283/72)$  is amended
  - (a) in clause (c), by the deletion of the word "and" after the semicolon;
  - (b) in subclause (d)(ii), by the deletion of the period and the substitution of the words "; and"; and
  - (c) by the addition of the following after clause (d);
  - (e) by the Eastern School District, Western School Board and the French Language School Board and used solely in school buses for the transportation of students.
- 2. These regulations come into force on 17 March 2007.

#### **EXPLANATORY NOTES**

**SECTION 1** authorizes the Eastern School District, Western School Board and the French Language School Board to purchase, store and use marked gasoline for the transportation of students in school buses.

**SECTION 2** provides for the commencement of these regulations.

# INSURANCE ACT PRINCE EDWARD ISLAND MUTUAL INSURANCE COMPANY DIVIDEND ORDERED

Having under consideration a request from the Prince Edward Island Mutual Insurance Company, and pursuant to subsection 317(3) of the *Insurance Act*, R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. I-4, Council ordered that a dividend in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the one year written premiums be paid from the reserve fund of the Prince Edward Island Mutual Insurance Company on or about 16 March 2007 to the policy holders of record as at 31 December 2006, and that the company provide the sum of one million, two hundred and fifty-three thousand dollars (\$1,253,000.00) for payment of the aforesaid dividend.

PRINCE EDWARD ISLAND LANDS PROTECTION ACT PROPERTY NO. 296509, LOT 64, KINGS COUNTY IDENTIFICATION FOR NON-DEVELOPMENT USE AMENDMENT

Pursuant to subsection 9(2) of the *Prince Edward Island Lands Protection Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. L-5, Council amended the condition of non-development use pursuant to section 2 of the Land Identification Regulations (EC606/95) in

respect of approximately sixty-three (63) acres of land, being Provincial Property No. 296509 located in Lot 64, Kings County, Prince Edward Island and currently owned by Donald L. Perkins and Nancy M. Perkins, both of High Bank, Prince Edward Island.

Council noted that this amendment will enable subdivision of an eighteen (18) acre parcel of land and determined that following subdivision, identification for non-development use shall continue to apply to the new parcel and the remaining land, until termination of the identification agreement in 2009.
